SPEAKER SPOTLIGHT – Anthony L. Rosner, Ph.D., LLD [Hon.], LLC



Dr. Rosner, is a 1972 graduate of Harvard University earning a PhD in biological chemistry/medical sciences. Dr. Rosner is a champion of interdisciplinary research in the health sciences, having previously served as research director of the International College of Applied Kinesiology, director of research and education at the Foundation for Chiropractic Education and Research, director of research initiatives at Parker College, department administrator in chemistry at Brandeis University, and technical director of multiple laboratories at a teaching hospital of Harvard University and of an affiliate of the Mayo Clinic. He is a former research director with Apex Energetics, Inc. He was designated as Humanitarian of the Year in 2000 by the American Chiropractic Association and holds an honorary degree from the National University of Health Sciences. Dr. Rosner has a warm and

engaging lecture presentation style, always ready to field questions regarding his extremely clear and well prepared material. Dr. Rosner will briefly review D.D. Palmers concept of "Neural Tone" and relate that to neurotransmitter function. He will also discuss the current status of the use of electrodiagnosis in chiropractic research, including Electroencephalograpphy and surface and needle electromyography, and "array" technique evoked potentials and transcutaneous nerve stimulation. He will review aspects of Applied Kinesiology related to electrodiagnosis and discuss research that he has personally performed in this area. Dr. Rosner will also review the scientific literature in regard to musculoskeletal and non-musculoskeletal physiologic responses to chiropractic manipulation.

<u>SPEAKER SPOTLIGHT</u> – David R. Seaman, DC



Dr. Seaman received his Bachelor of Science degree (Biology) from Rutgers University in 1982. He received his Doctor of Chiropractic degree from New York Chiropractic College in 1986, and his Masters in Science (Biology/Nutrition) from the University of Bridgeport in 1991. He has served as Professor, Department of Clinical Sciences, National University of Health Sciences, and as a consultant and Director of Clinical Education for Anabolic Laboratories. Dr. Seaman was formerly an Adjunct Associate Professor in Clinical Sciences at Palmer College of Chiropractic Florida. He is on the Post Professional Faculty of National University of Health Sciences, New York College of Chiropractic, and Northwestern Health Sciences University. He is past Director of the Council on Nutrition of the American Chiropractic Association.

Dr. Seaman has been writing and presenting information about chronic inflammation for 25 years. He was interested in this topic long before it become a mainstream topic of focus in relation to chronic disease expression. Dr. Seaman has written many articles and two books on the topic. He coined the term "diet-induced proinflammatory state" which has been cited as a reference in numerous articles, including publications by Harvard Medical School and the Center for Disease Control (CDC). Dr. Seaman will explore Hypocapnia (reduced blood levels of carbon dioxide) and how to identify and treat this common but rarely identified disorder. He will also discuss the Neurology of Ethics and self control, using his well prepared and presented highly informative and always humorous lecture style.
